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SENS Announcements (SA)

Selected Releases

NEPI Rockcastle: On Thursday, NRP released yet another SENS announcement regarding the reports published by Viceroy Research. In it, the group confirmed that it has made a written submission to each of the JSE, the Financial Sector Conduct Authority in South Africa, the Dutch Authority for the Financial Markets and Euronext Amsterdam requesting inter alia an investigation into trading in NEPI Rockcastle shares in the days leading up to and immediately following the publication of the Viceroy Report. Furthermore, having discredited with full transparency all accusations and allegations made, NEPI Rockcastle believes that the only purpose of the said report was to knowingly disseminate false and/or misleading information regarding the group. As a result, NRP has requested the above-mentioned authorities to investigate any market manipulation offences that may have occurred. NEPI Rockcastle also noted the latest report which was released by Viceroy on Thursday. Despite the group's public commitment to discuss any concerns regarding its activities directly, Viceroy has published a new report without contacting it for comment or to confirm the accuracy of the information contained therein. Lastly, NRP stated that Viceroy's latest report continues to spread inaccurate information, which it considers to be a further instance of market manipulation.

EPP N.V.: Yesterday saw EPP issue its results for the nine months ended 30 September 2018. During the period, the value of the group's investment properties exceeded €2bn. At the end of the period, EPP's net asset value stood at €991.1mn, or €1.33 per share. Other highlights included a 37% increase in net property income to €102.2mn, while earnings available for distribution per share increased by 4% to €0.0875. Lastly, despite only declaring a dividend every six months, EPP remains confident that it will deliver on its stated full-year distribution per share guidance of between €0.116 and €0.118.

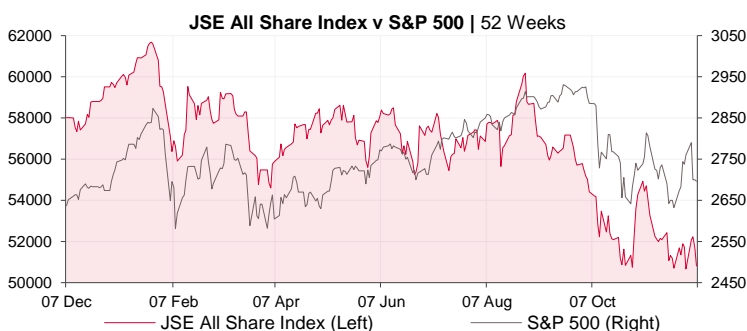
South African Market Headlines

Selected Headlines

The JSE traded sharply lower yesterday, negatively impacted by global risk-off sentiment. By the end of the session, the All Share index had fallen 1.75% as it moved to settle at 50,806 index points, outperforming a 1.96% decline on the Top 40. The banking and financial indices featured among the worst performers, down 3% and 2.29% respectively, dragged down by a weaker rand. Absa shed 3.36%, while Standard Bank ended 3.29% lower. Among financials, Old Mutual lost 4.9%, while Sanlam extended its recent declines after it fell 3.05%. Finally, the gold mining index once again performed extremely well, up 4.54%.

 During the previous session, Wall Street ended mostly lower in what turned out to be a volatile day of trade. Despite plunging earlier on, US indices reversed most of their losses as the day progressed, helped along by a report that the US Federal Reserve may turn more accommodative. The Dow Jones shed 0.32% to close at 24,947.67 index points, despite falling more than 700 points earlier on in the session. Meanwhile, the S&P 500 lost 0.15%, but the NASDAQ managed to gain 0.42% and settle in positive territory.

European & Asian Markets

European Market Headlines

European indices slumped on Thursday, weighed down by a sharp decline in oil prices as well as increased tensions between China and the US following the arrest of the CFO of Huawei Technologies. The Stoxx 600 ended 3.1% lower at 343.31 index points, with a 3.48% plunge in the German DAX among the region's worst performers. The French CAC 40 followed close behind after it lost 3.32%, while the FTSE 100 shed 3.15% to close at just above the 6,700 index point level. Among specific shares, Bayer fell 5.3% despite the group setting ambitious growth and margin targets through to 2022.

Asian Market Headlines

This morning saw Asian markets awash in green, with indices benefitting from last night's sharp reversal in US indices. In addition, equity markets found support from hopes that the US Federal Reserve's hiking cycle may be near its end. The Japanese Nikkei managed to add 0.43%, with the index set to end higher for the first time in four sessions. Meanwhile, the Australian ASX gained 0.42%, on track to more than offset yesterday's 0.22% decline. Lastly, mainland indices were only slightly higher as the Shanghai Composite and the Hang Seng gained 0.08% and 0.26% respectively.

Commodities & Currency Pairs

Commodity Headlines

Oil prices endured a choppy session of trade on Thursday, but the industrial commodity was sharply lower by the end of the day. This was mainly due to investors remaining cautious ahead of the outcome of a meeting between OPEC and its allies. According to reports, OPEC has tentatively agreed to cut output, but still needs a commitment from Russia before deciding volumes. In response, Brent crude lost 2.4%, or \$1.5, to settle at \$60.06 per barrel, despite dropping to a low of \$58.36 per barrel earlier on in the day. Lastly, this morning saw Brent lose another 0.55% to \$59.73 per barrel, while spot gold managed to add 0.21% to \$1,240.42/oz.

Currency Headlines

Yesterday saw the rand once again break above the R14/\$ level, with the local currency impacted by risk-off sentiment as well as the release of disappointing current account data. In the third quarter, South Africa's current account deficit widened to 3.5% of GDP, marginally higher than the 3.4% recorded in the previous quarter. After trading at a high of R13.86/\$ at 10:00, the rand plunged to a low of R14.20/\$ at 18:30. Lastly, the local currency managed to trim some of its losses overnight and was last at around the R14.05/\$ level this morning.

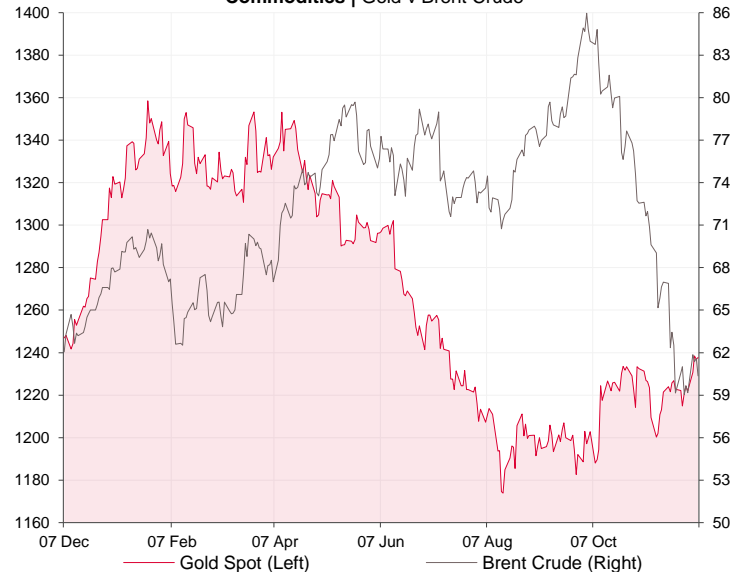

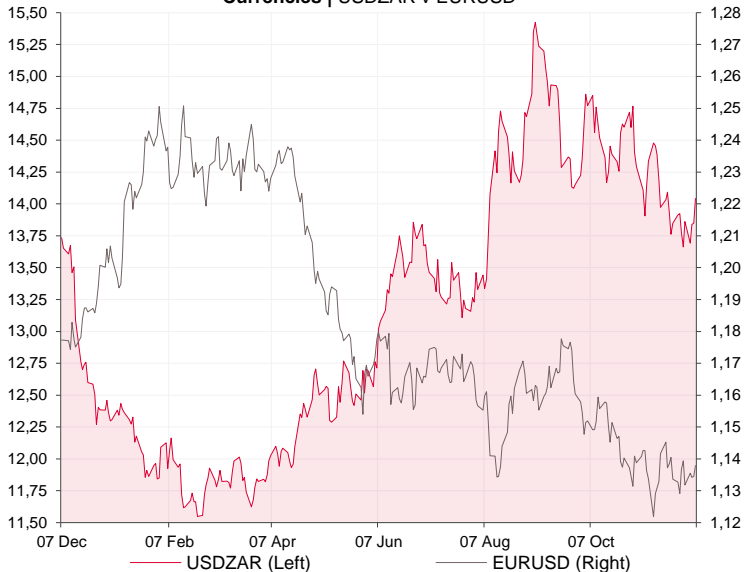

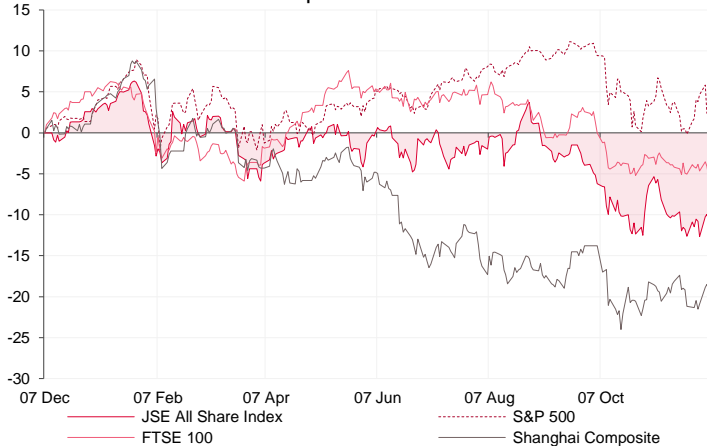

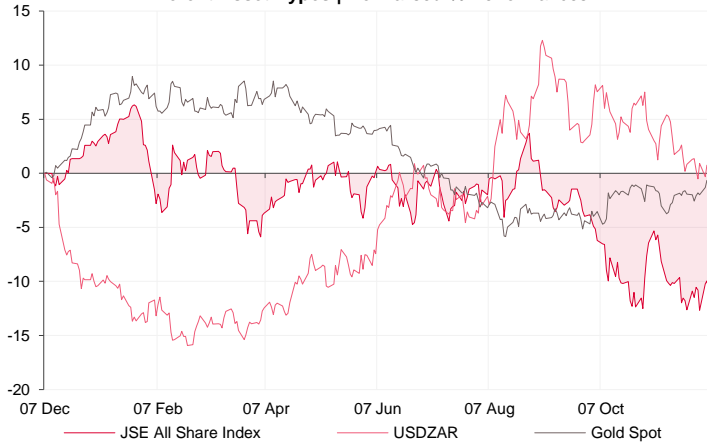
