NEPI Rockcastle: On Wednesday morning, NRP released a SENS announcement detailing Fitch's reaction to the report released by Viceroy Research. Following S&P Global Ratings' confirmation of NEPI Rockcastle's BBB rating in response to the publication of the report by Viceroy, Fitch Ratings confirmed on the 4th of December 2018 that it views the allegations in the report as unsubstantiated and therefore neutral to NRP's BBB rating. In addition, Fitch also noted: 'Despite rapid growth, the company has maintained a conservative financial profile with sound liquidity and a high degree of financial flexibility. The stable outlook reflects our expectations that NEPI Rockcastle will continue its expansion, while maintaining its conservative financial profile, by funding through a combination of debt and equity.'

Sanlam: During the previous session, SLM issued an operational update. In it, the group advised shareholders that it has made significant strategic progress in the four months since the end of June up to the end of October 2018. During this period, Sanlam concluded the largest transaction in its history by finalising the acquisition of the remaining stake in Saham Finances. This transaction will create a unique footprint and competitive advantage for Sanlam across the African continent to drive future growth. Furthermore, the group's clusters continued to execute their operational strategies and delivered an overall resilient performance for the 10 months ended 31 October 2018. This is a pleasing result in the context of weak economic conditions in a number of its territories, including South Africa, and significant volatility in global investment and currency markets. During the period, Sanlam recorded a 3% increase in new business volumes to R188bn. Meanwhile, normalised headline earnings declined by 10%, mainly due to a 55% drop in net investment returns. Looking forward, the group expects that the economic and operating environment will remain subdued in its largest markets for the remainder of 2018.

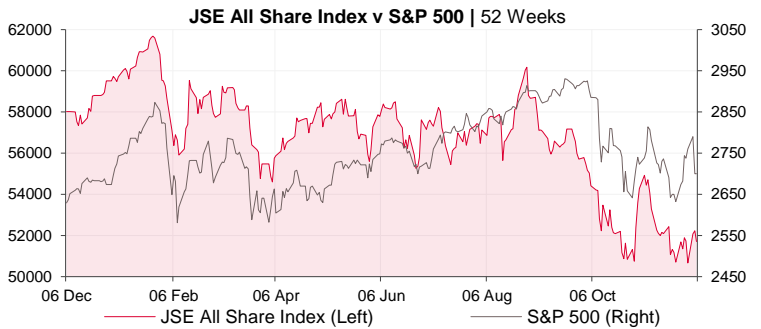

Selected Headlines

Local markets endured a tough session on Wednesday, weighed down by broad-based losses and Wall Street's sharp decline on Tuesday. However, trade was subdued due to the closure of US markets. By the end of the session, the JSE All Share index had fallen 1.01% to settle at 51,709.2 index points, outperforming a 1.06% decline on the Top 40. Food and drug retailers were among the worst performers, down 2.13%, followed by a 1.68% decline among financials. Sanlam weighed on the financial index after it lost 4.08%, impacted by the release of an operational update. On the upside, the gold mining index gained 1.69%, helped along by a 3.82% increase in Harmony Gold.

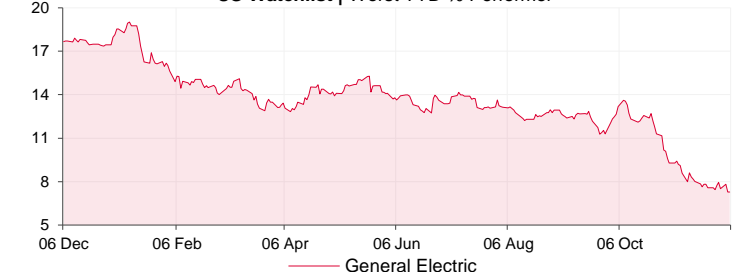

European & Asian Markets

European Market Headlines

Yesterday saw European indices extend their recent losses, dragged down by a sell-off in global equity markets. The Stoxx 600 shed 1.16% to close at 354.27 index points, with the FTSE 100 ending 1.44% lower. The decline in the FTSE was partly due to Brexit debates occurring in parliament, with Prime Minister Theresa May suffering a number of losses which drove the pound down to its lowest level in nearly two months. Meanwhile, the French CAC 40 had fallen 1.36%, followed by a 1.19% decline in the German DAX as it moved to settle at just above the 11,200 index point level.

Asian Market Headlines

Asian indices declined sharply this morning, negatively affected by lingering concerns over the 90-day ceasefire between the US and China. Mainland markets featured among the worst performers, with the Hang Seng slumping 2.56%. Meanwhile, the Japanese Nikkei had fallen 1.84%, with the index set to end lower for the third consecutive session, while the Shanghai Composite lost 1.28% by the break. Lastly, this was followed by a 0.54% drop in the Australian ASX as it remained on track to extend yesterday's 0.83% decline.

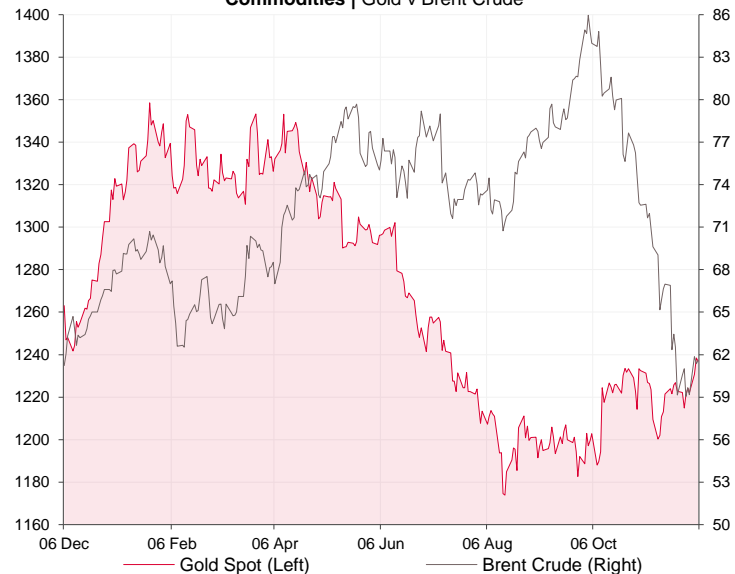
Commodity Headlines

Oil prices dropped during the previous session, with investors remaining on the sidelines ahead of a meeting between the world's biggest exporters who will discuss the possibility of cutting output in order to boost prices. As a result, Brent crude lost \$0.52 to close at \$61.56 per barrel, despite touching a high of \$63.29 per barrel earlier on in the day. This morning saw the industrial commodity lose 0.41%, or \$0.25, to \$61.31 per barrel. In contrast, spot gold gained 0.16% to \$1,239.29/oz this morning, with the precious metal at its highest level in more than five weeks. Finally, iron ore was at \$66.20 per tonne, 0.95% lower than its previous close.

Commodities | Gold v Brent Crude



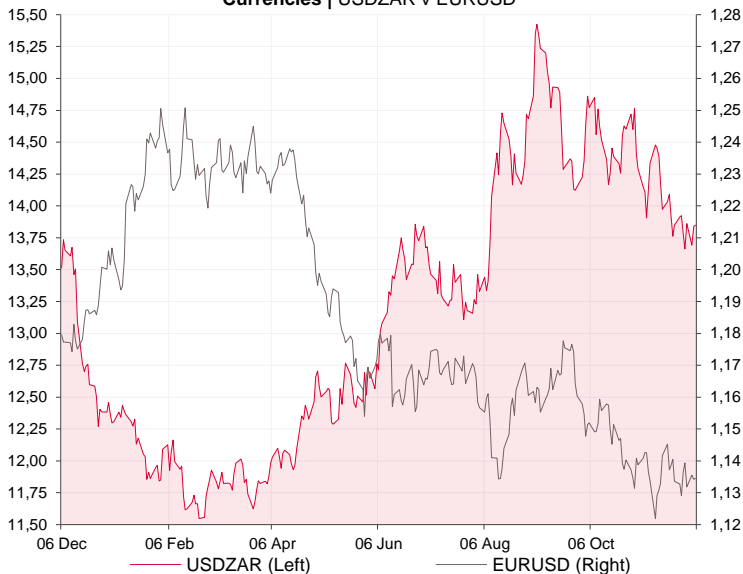
Currency Headlines

Wednesday saw the rand undergo yet another choppy session of trade, as it first strengthened against most global currencies before erasing all of its gains as the day progressed. Earlier on, the rand benefitted from the release of upbeat PMI data. During November, Standard Bank's purchasing managers' index increased to 48.2 points, marginally higher than the 46.9 points recorded previously. After trading at R13.87/\$ at 9:30, the rand rose to a high of R13.73/\$ at 11:00. However, by 17:40, the local currency had fallen to R13.86/\$, before dropping to just above the R13.90/\$ level this morning.

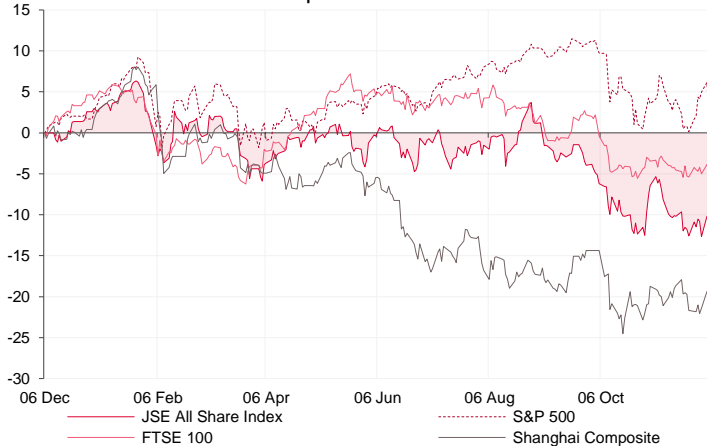

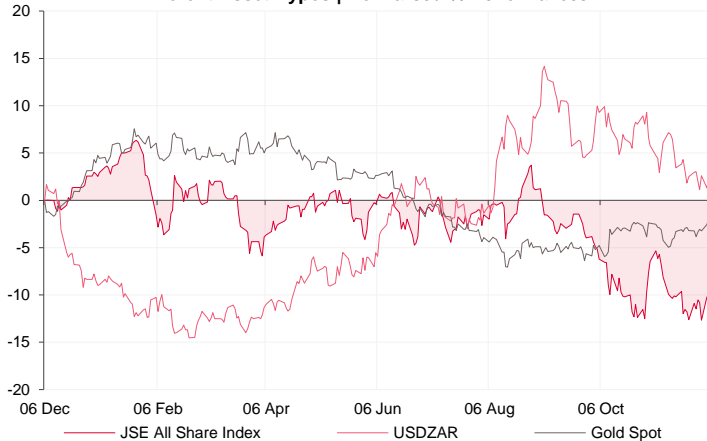
